Dear Parent or Guardian,

Today your child participated in a classroom program called **PICKLES: Positive Influences Changing Kids' Lives in Elementary Schools**. The program was created by our organization with the assistance of educators and funded in part by Island Thrift and the Washington Traffic Safety Commission.

Why? Studies, both locally and nationally, show that children are beginning to drink at very young ages, sometimes before they finish elementary school. These are our future drivers.

Therefore the goal of PICKLES is to help prepare children to make healthy and responsible decisions about alcohol and other drug use, and reinforce at an early age the "no use" drugs message. In addressing this goal the program seeks to teach students that: 1) Children should not drink alcohol and 2) Adults should not drink/drug and drive.

The format of the program: a 45-minute presentation that includes McGruff safety materials including a hand puppet, coloring book, pencil and stickers; a 9-minute age-appropriate video with a sing-a-long, and talking about: healthy and unhealthy drinks for children, people you trust, impaired driving, and reinforcement activities with the children.

The PICKLES program is not intended to be a comprehensive, all-inclusive alcohol education curriculum. It is offered as another layer of positive influences to buffer children from the dangers of underage drinking, and ultimately drinking and driving.
